ONE YEAR ACTION PLAN AND
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

The Consolidated Plan is prepared by the Penn Hills Department of Planning and Economic Development every five years and submitted to the Department of Housing and Urban Development in accordance with Federal regulations. The Plan serves as the Municipality's planning document to guide the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Home Investment Partnerships (HOME) and its application for funding. The Plan consists of seven (7) parts: housing and homeless needs assessment, housing market analysis, strategic plan, action plan, certifications, monitoring, and Outcome Performance Measurement. The Action Plan is an annual description of the Grantee's expected funding and the activities that the Grantee will undertake in the coming year.
