## GENERAL INFORMATION

**WHAT IS INCLUDED IN PROGRAM COSTS?** The cost for each program is listed. The cost includes instruction and fees, but may not include special equipment, or uniforms which may be required.

**HOW DO I OBTAIN A REFUND?** For programs meeting for three or more days, students withdrawing before the second class meeting shall be entitled to a refund minus fees paid. For programs meeting two days or less, students withdrawing before the first day of class shall be entitled to a full refund.

**WHAT HAPPENS IF A PROGRAM I SIGN UP FOR IS CANCELLED?** All programs have a minimum enrollment and may be cancelled if that enrollment is not met. If this occurs, you will receive a refund if you do not transfer to a different program.

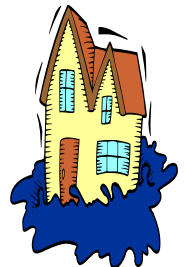
### 1ST ANNUAL CAMPOUT IN THE PARK
